A written referral by your Primary MD for Diabetes Education and Nutritional Counseling

- Meet with Endocrinology MD twice a year (every 6 months)
- Meet with the Diabetes
 Education RN Counseling (free
 service) once yearly if A1C <
 7% annually, twice yearly if
 A1C > 7% every 6 months!
- Meet twice a year the Nutritional Counselor
- Retinal visit with an ophthalmologist within the first 6 months
- Labs: Blood glucose level, A1C, Renal Function, UA Proteinuria, Fructosamine (if necessary).
- Meet or follow up with the Chronic Disease Manager
- Follow up with the Pharmacy Case Manager for any issues or questions regarding this program.



Our goal is to help you achieve and maintain your health goals and assist you with your medical benefits. We are looking forward to your participation in PIP.

If at any time of the year the criteria/process is not being met the benefit will be removed by the PCM

This benefit is available year-round for new employees or newly diagnosed Diabetics using Inj. Insulins. Those returning to PIP and successfully completed the prior tasks should sign up Oct. 1. Consideration will be case by case by the Pharmacy Case Manager.

What is PIP?

The Gulf Coast Medical
Management Pharmacy Case
Management is pleased to continue
the benefit called "Pharmacy
Insulin Program" (PIP) which began
on Oct. 1, 2017. We have
recognized how the high cost of
insulin is affecting your treatment

possibility to help decrease the cost
of your insulin.



Who is eligible?

The voluntary benefit is available during the plan year starting in Oct. up until March 1st yearly for you or for your dependents. PIP is for Insulin dependent Type 1 or Type 2 diabetics on an injectable insulin or injectable GLP. Pharmacy Case Management recognizes you or possibly your dependents may benefit from this benefit offered by Sarasota Memorial Hospital for their employees. We would like to have the opportunity to discuss and tell you more about how the benefit is available for next the plan year

that may help decrease your cost of insulin and continuous glucose monitoring devices offered thru this program.

How do I request an appointment?

Step 1: Meet with the PCM.

Step 2: Critiera to meet:

- PCM will verify the members form claim history with injectable insulin or injectable GLP dosing when members apply thru GCMM website.
- 2. If approved the \$1500 and 80/20 benefit will also be applied.

- 3. Diagnosis of Type I or II diabetes
- 4. Has met with PCM.
- 5. Must agree to all "tasks."
- 6. Not eligible for "patient assistance program"
 - a. The member will supply a denial letter from PAP.

Once this criteria is met the PCM will add the benefit to your pharmacy account thru Navitus.

Step 3: PIP Process

Once you have been approved for the PIP program and have agreed to the terms. The process below is expected. If you do not meet the process requirements throughout the year the PIP benefit can be removed from your benefit at any time of the year.

- Must use the Birdi Mail Order
- Primary MD appointment annually
